MATERNAL CHILD HEALTH

New or expecting parents are provided with education and resources pertaining to childbirth, breast-feeding, immunizations, car seat safety, safe sleep and healthy growth and development through home/office visits and events. Families meet with staff to receive education, support and immunizations as needed.

ELIGIBILITY

Participants accrue Nest Points through participation in the program, which can be redeemed for infant and toddler products. Families are eligible from pregnancy until the child is five years old.

Enrolled FCP Tribal Elders and disabled adults within our service area are provided with proper care and needed services, so they can maintain independence and remain in their homes as long as reasonably possible.

Need for services is based on an assessment by the In-Home Care Nurse and Community Health Representative. Services will be made available to participants who reside within a 30-mile radius of FCPHWC or a 30-mile radius of We Care in Carter.
